

Swedish for immigrants

Swedish for immigrants (SFI) is a qualified language education that aims to provide adults with a mothertongue other than Swedish with basic knowledge of the Swedish language. In the education you get to learn and develop a functional second language.

You get to study SFI in Svedala:

- From 1 July of the year you turn 16
- If you are registered in Svedala.
- Has a social security number
- Lacks basic knowledge of Swedish, Norwegian and Danish

Contribute to active participation in society

Education in SFI must also provide linguistic tools for communication and active participation in everyday, social and working life. The education is characterized by the student developing a communicative language ability. This means being able to communicate both orally and in writing based on their needs. The starting point for the education must be the individual's needs and conditions.

Adults should have basic reading and writing skills

Furthermore, the education must give adult immigrants who lack basic reading and writing skills the opportunity to acquire such. This can apply to illiterates as well as students with a short school background, but also students who are literate but have a different written language.
